## Training course GENERAL THEORY OF NOONOMY

at the North-West Institute of Management of the Russian Presidential Academy of National Economy and Public Administration

Since 2020, the North-West Institute of Management of RANEPA (NWIM RANEPA) has been running a Master's course in Strategic *Management and Quality of Life* at the Department of State and Community Management, offering the discipline of *General Theory of Noonomy* to Master's students.

The course *General Theory of Noonomy* is based on the ideas of the new industrial society and its principles elaborated in the works on Noonomy by S. Bodrunov. The ideas of Noonomy develop the theory of the New Industrial Society of the Second Generation (NIS.2), which was also developed by the author and is its logical continuation. Students are offered a non-linear view of the future of society and the state, i.e. a choice of the further path of development. Global civilisational development, based on accelerated technological progress and knowledge-intensive production, inevitably leads to the formation of NIS.2, which drastically changes the social fabric. This inevitably increases the importance of training professionals with the necessary skills to select and further implement strategies for sustainable development (transition to Noonomy) and the prevention of social and man-made disasters (the inert path).

The distinctive feature of the discipline taught at NWI is a more detailed and in-depth study of the principles of state structure and governance that best meet the challenges of the transition to Noonomy. That is, it looks at the transformation of the role of knowledge in social life and the inclusion of this subject in the sphere of the most important issues of the state, based on the ideas of NIS.2.

The methodological basis of the course *The General Theory of Noonomy* is the textbook *The General Theory of Noonomy*, the monographs *The Coming. The new industrial society: reloading, Noonomy, Noonomy: the trajectory of global transformation* (by S. Bodrunov), as well as the textbook *Public administration in Noonomy* developed by the Faculty of State and Local Administration of NWIM RANEPA.

The course is taught by L. Dorofeeva, PhD economist, associate professor of the Department of State and Local Government at the NWIM RANEPA.

The discipline raises the following issues:

- The emergence of a new role of knowledge in society and in the economy;
- Conditions for the formation of a new industrial society;

- The subject matter and main management approaches of the general theory of economics;
- The stages of evolution of industrial development;
- The transformation of the principles of public administration in the modern conditions of the informatisation of society;
  - Features of the transformation of state functions during the transition to Noonomy;
  - The development of methods of state regulation in the transition to Noonomy;
  - Transformation of state institutions due to the changing role of knowledge in society;
  - Public administration in the main areas of social life.

The programme is intended for students studying in the field of education 38.04.04 *Public and municipal management* of the level of higher professional education with the qualification (degree) "Master".

The aim of the course is to train personnel for the "economic block" of federal and regional bodies of state power and local self-government, as well as for work in leading positions in state enterprises and development institutions.
