The book *Strategizing Societal Transformation: Knowledge, Technologies, and Noonomy* by V. Kvint and S. Bodrunov, members of the Russian Academy of Sciences, has been published by an international publisher, Apple Academic Press (simultaneously in the USA, Canada and Great Britain).

The publication reflects the assessments and views of the co-authors on the global trends in the transformation of society today, on the strategic priorities and goals of social development set by these trends, and on the strategic ways to achieve them in order to advance national interests.

Currently, the monograph *Strategizing Social Transformation: Knowledge, Technologies, and Noonomy* has been acquired by the libraries of about 80 foreign universities as well as by the Library of Congress and the British Library. The publication is freely available in these libraries.

Anthology of Noonomy: Fourth Technological Revolution and its Economic, Social and Humanitarian Consequences

The book *Anthology of Noonomy: Fourth Technological Revolution and Its Economic, Social and Humanitarian Consequences* has been published by Brill Publishers in the Netherlands. The book is published in the series "Studies in Current Social Sciences".

Written by an international team of authors from leading universities in Russia, the USA, Canada, China, Europe and Latin America, the book highlights various aspects of the theory of Noonomy developed by Professor S. Bodrunov and the S.Y. Witte Institute for New Industrial Development (INID), which he directs. In this book, the key points of this theory (transition to knowledge-intensive production, gradual socialisation of society, spread of property, progress of solidarity relations, abolition of simulative needs and progress of cultural man) are assessed, and the thesis of Noonomy as the post-economic future of society is discussed. Great attention is paid to the global context of contemporary technological and socio-economic transformations and to the issues of political-economic and socio-philosophical understanding of the theory of Noonomy. It is shown that the elaboration of strategies for technological and socio-economic development should be consistent with the historical challenges humanity facing and that the way to avoid global catastrophes, at whose threshold we stand, is to advance in the direction whose main reference points are set by the theory of Noonomy.
