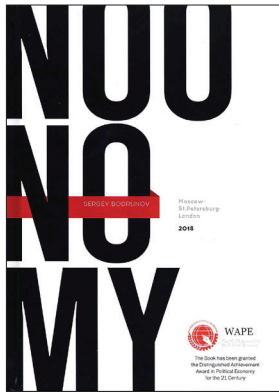
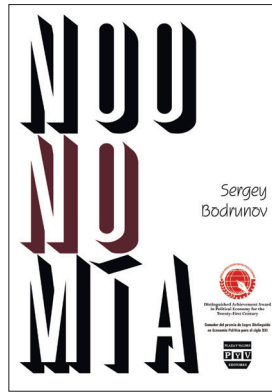


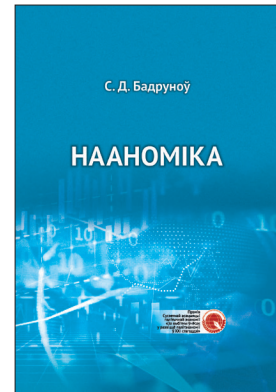
Since its publication in Russian (2018), *Noonomy* has also been published in English, Croatian, Spanish, Portuguese, Belarusian, and Hebrew.



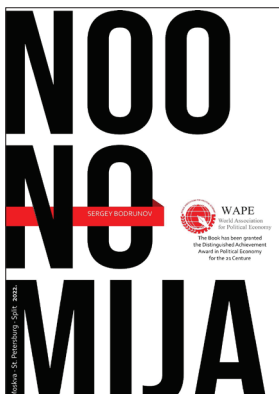
